Island Green: Any throw from the Tee must come-to-rest on the Island Green to be able to mark on the Island Green. Throws from the Tee that don't come to rest on the Island Green, must proceed to the Drop Zone with a penalty throw. All subsequent throws from the Drop Zone or Island Green use normal OB rules.



PLAYOFF

In the event of a tie for 1st place in any category, a sudden-death playoff will be held after the final round.

Tied players will be required to play **holes 18, 16 and 17** repeteadly until one of them wins a hole outright.

According to 2022 PDGA's Rules (Sec. 1.09), the specific order in which players tee off for sudden-death play shall be determined by random draw. In the case of a tied hole during sudden-death play, the teeing order for the next hole will rotate from the order used on the just completed hole.
