

The paved road behind the basket and beyond is out of bounds (OB). Note that the lower sidewalk is NOT out of bounds (OB). If the throw misses the MANDATORY, proceed to the drop zone (DZ) with a +1 penalty.





If the tee shot lands OB, players may choose to proceed to the designated drop zone (DZ) with a +1 penalty.

PLAYERS MEETING

Players Metting will be held near the Cafeteria area at 1:00 PM on Friday.

MANDATORY CHECK-IN

In-person check-in with the TD or TDA must be completed before Friday, April 18 at 1:30 PM. The TD and/or TDA will be available near the Cafeteria area from 12:30 PM on Friday.

TIE BREAK

Players tied for any of the top three positions in any division must play a dudden-death playoff, beginning as soon as possible after the third round is completed.

Tied players must play holes 18, then 19, and then continue from hole 1 until one of them wins a hole outright.

According to the PDGA Rules (Section 1.09), the specific order in which players tee off on the first hole of a sudden-death playoff will be determined by random draw. If a hole is tied during the playoff, the teeing order for the next hole will rotate based on the order used on the hole just completed.
